Mansion 2025-56 Entrecasteaux

In the heart of the picturesque village of Entrecasteaux, this magnificent 18th-century oil mill has been carefully restored, combining old-world charm with the finest contemporary comforts. Hidden from view, behind typical Provençal walls, the property opens onto a private terrace with a swimming pool, a true haven of peace for sunny days. The living spaces, spread over two levels, have been elegantly renovated. Custom-designed storage units maximize the space while enhancing the aesthetics of the space. The light-filled living room offers a warm ambiance with its fireplace and unobstructed views of the garden and terrace. The bright dining room flows seamlessly into an open kitchen, ideal for entertaining. Two elegant bedrooms, a bathroom, and a powder room complete this level. On the garden level, an additional room can be converted into a guest bedroom or creative space. A rare feature, the two original former oil mills—each approximately 57 m²—frame the lower level. One has been tastefully transformed into a unique reception space, the other currently serves as a storage room. The current owners regularly host classical music concerts there, welcoming up to 85 guests. With a separate entrance, this unique venue offers great potential: an art gallery, workshop, reception hall, or even an intimate restaurant.
