Access is via a private path leading to a fortified enclosure, hidden in the heart of more than 20 hectares of forest. To the south, an impressive cliff protects the site, guaranteeing absolute peace and privacy. Here, time seems to stand still, and each stone tells a fragment of history. The estate is a rare refuge, a true invitation to recharge, contemplate, and experience the art of living. The château offers approximately 375 m<sup>2</sup> of living space, with a total built-up area of over 600 m<sup>2</sup>. Three lounges, a dining room, and a characterful kitchen welcome your moments of sharing and reception in a refined and warm setting. The sleeping area consists of seven bedrooms, including a vast 50 m<sup>2</sup> library-office with a private terrace offering panoramic views, and a separate master suite of over 15 m<sup>2</sup> located on the top floor.
